Organisers to ensure the following:-

Guidelines for participants

- A copy of the 'Bitterne Park Cricket Club Guidelines for Participants' to be added to the BPCC website.
- BPCC Guidelines to be circulated to all players selected prior to the match.
- A laminated copy of the BPCC Guidelines to be held by the designated BPCC Matchday Captain (the 'Captain') for ease of reference.
- The Captain to remind participants of the guidelines prior to the match.

Track and Trace

- Team selector to keep a 'covid-19 track and trace' list of all selected participant names, phone numbers and / or email addresses.
- Team Selector to advise the Captain of the participant names prior to the match.
- The Captain to collect names and phone numbers or email addresses of any participants not included in the original list provided by the Team Selector. Details to be passed to the Team Selector within 12 hours of the close of play.
- The Captain or their nominated deputy to display the relevant BPCC Venue 'Track and Trace' QR code.
- Team selector to destroy / delete the 'covid-19 track and trace' list 21 days after the match.

Matchday Venue & Hygiene

- The Captain and opposition Team Captain to check the ground is ready and safe to play
- The Umpires shall ensure there is a maximum on the pitch at any one time of 11 players from the fielding side, two batsman (plus a maximum of one 'runner' if required), and two umpires.
- The Captain or their nominated deputy to ensure hand sanitiser and wipes are available for participants during hygiene breaks.
- The Captain or their nominated deputy to ensure hand sanitiser / cleaning equipment is available for cleaning shared equipment.
- The Captain or their nominated deputy to collect and clean shared equipment.
- The Captain or their nominated deputy (preferably matchday scorer) to clean any communal seating area used by scorers.
